AutoCAD is a registered trademark of Autodesk, Inc., a company located in San Rafael, California, that originally developed AutoCAD. Autodesk can import and export drawings to other file formats, including .dwg, .dxf, .dwt, .dot, .pdf, .stl, .udf, .off, .rvt, and .scn. DXF export allows users to modify a drawing in another application and import it back into AutoCAD. History AutoCAD's original namesake application was built by a small team of designers in the Autodesk offices in 1986, using the relatively new technology of PC clones of the Apple II and other personal computers, which featured pre-installed AutoCAD. Autodesk held the copyright to AutoCAD, for several years, as the software would not run on any other machine. The initial version, AutoCAD 1.0, was released in 1987, with the last version of AutoCAD until 2012 being AutoCAD 12. (In 2014, Autodesk returned to the AutoCAD brand with AutoCAD LT.) AutoCAD 1.0 was a 32-bit application, but was followed by a 64-bit version in 1988. The first version of the AutoCAD Architecture suite, introduced in 1989, contained numerous features not previously available, including database connectivity and full two-dimensional support. In 1990, AutoCAD Revit was introduced as a presentation tool for architects, incorporating floor plans, elevations, and more. With the release of Revit Architecture in 1998, AutoCAD was spun off into a separate company. In 2004, Autodesk released AutoCAD LT, a free 32-bit version of AutoCAD, which has since been enhanced to offer many of the

features of the full AutoCAD applications. Also in 2004, Autodesk released Autodesk Architectural Desktop, a combined Revit and AutoCAD application. In 2009, AutoCAD 2D was released to coincide with the release of AutoCAD LT 2009. In 2012, Autodesk released AutoCAD 2013, a successor to AutoCAD LT 2009.
